Here is the latest update from the SteamWorld universe. It's been a very busy couple of months as we are back in full production.

CASTING NEWS

We will need a lot of Extras for the film shoot on Saturday, June 21st. It's the epic Indians Vs. Werewolf fight. The more people we have out the better the fight will look. It'll be about an 8 hour day and food will be provided. So if you want to have no stress fun, eat Indians or kill Werewolves please let me know ASAP so I can arrange for sufficient food and beverages. Contact me and I will go through costuming with you and sign you up for the day. This time around we are signing releases for extras. There is a monetary connection to the shoot. We are in full production on this, a month into principal photography. We have assembled an amazing cast and crew and are very excited about the footage so far. The plan is to shoot through the summer.

This project marks a number of first's for SteamWorld – first weekday shoot, first paid location shoot, first insured shoot, first time using a second unit, first time using multiple cameras. This means that our most ambitious project to date has stepped us up a notch.

We spent a full week at Westfield Village shooting the doomed town of Perdition. Having the right location is so essential to the whole look and feel. I also want to thank John Demeter who provided our hungry cast and crew with craft service on the Thursday/Friday of the shoot. It certainly helps the budget when we receive such a kind donation of time and resources.
